ROCKY MOUNTAIN SEARCH DOG AIR SCENT AND TRAILING SEMINAR SEPTEMBER 8TH, 9TH, & 10TH, 2017 FAIRPLAY, CO

SEMINAR FOCUS: Wilderness Air Scent and Trailing Beginner to Intermediate Level.

Air Scent:

*Air Scent levels will involve up to 40 acre search problems involving a single subject and include the following areas of focus:

Scent Discrimination
Subject location and indicating the find to the handler in a pre-described reliable manner;
A variety of wind patterns,
Scent Pools
Area/Terrain Gridding
Terrain strategy.

Trailing:

Trailing problems will involve trail lengths up to ½ mile with 2-3 turns and include the following areas of focus: Scent Discrimination

Direction of travel

Various trail lengths and age

Turn navigation and proficiency

SEMINAR STRUCTURE:

- Each group will be include the following:
 - 4 seminar participant handlers, maximum
 - 1-2 Search and Rescue Dogs of Colorado Certified handler(s) as Coach(es)
 - Videographer
 - Volunteer subjects
- Schedule of events:

Friday: 8-12, break, 13:00-16:00 pm, break, dinner, evening presentations.
 Saturday: 8-12, break, 13:00-16:00 pm, break, dinner, evening presentations.

Sunday: 8-12, Debrief, Depart.

SEMINAR OBJECTIVES:

- Create a strong and solid reward system for the dog
- Foster a solid and positive dog-handler relationship
- Develop a reliable Find and Refined system that works
- Learn techniques to keep the dog motivated and energized to do search work
- Develop an understanding of search strategy
- Build skills in reading alerts consistently
- Learn to utilize a navigation/support person
- Develop a familiarity with the unique scent pictures of the Rocky Mountain Region

LOCATION: Fairplay, CO – Elevation 9950 feet and beyond!

LODGING: Multi Bedroom Mountain home, 3 Baths, (Sleeps 25):
